HiSET: High School Equivalency Test

Registration Process for Test Takers over 18

1. Begin on the ETS website– hiset.ets.org Click orange box "For Test Takers" . In the top menu bar click on "Sign In/Create My Hiset Account." Fill out the information. Make note of your username, password, and Account ID#. The ID# will look like this– BV54RFG
2. Decide if paper–based or computer-based testing is best for you. The fee is the same. One advantage to computer-based testing is that the test will be scored immediately, with the exception of the Writing test, which will take an additional 7-10 days.
3. "Schedule Your Exam" is found on the home page. You will see the available dates/times at our center: Keene Community Education. Register and pay for your test dates. You will pay with credit card, Paypal, or a voucher code.
4. For full battery of HiSET tests, register for both test days. In case of inclement weather, testing will be rescheduled through the HiSET portal.
5. On the test date, arrive at Community Education 15 minutes prior to the testing time. Remember to bring a government-issued photo ID such as a passport, non-driver's ID, or driver's license. A birth certificate or student ID are NOT acceptable.
6. **Test Takers under 18 years old**, contact Community Education or your local high school guidance office for information.

- Pretests- \$5.00 for each pretest. Call to register.
- HiSET fees- \$25.00 per subtest/ \$125.00 for the total battery
- HiSET retakes: \$10.00/ \$14.25. Please ask for more information.
- Scholarships are available. Speak to Vicki Farrington for more information.

- **Test Takers under 18** must have a signed Age Waiver Form <https://www.nhadulted.org/programs/hiset/underage-youth/>
- Government-issued photo ID is required: passport, driver's license, non-driver's ID. Birth certificate and student ID are not acceptable
