Adult Basic Education (ABE)

Math- Monday, 9am-noon: September 12-December 12 Instructor- Rachel Bartlett
Designed for students who desire a comprehensive review of math, including pre-algebra, geometry, decimals, fractions, and whole number skills and for students who are studying for the high school equivalency test (HiSET.) Individualized instruction is available.

Reading/Writing- Wednesday, 9am-noon: September 14-December 14 Instructor- Laura Mack
Designed for students who desire a comprehensive review of adult literacy skills, including reading for comprehension, grammar/usage, and language mechanics and for students who are studying for the high school equivalency test (HiSET.) Students will also learn how to write a five-paragraph persuasive essay. Instruction will include topics in science and social studies.
